

PDAP Claim Information for Livestock Losses

The Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP) is part of the Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency (SPSA).

PDAP helps residents, small businesses, non-profits, agricultural operations and communities recover from natural disasters such as flooding, tornadoes, plow winds and other severe weather.

PDAP may help cover essential losses not insured, including cleanup, repairs and temporary relocation.



How to apply

Before you can apply, your local authority must be approved for PDAP. Contact your local authority to see if they are designated.

If they are approved, they can provide an application package. If not, you must report your losses to them so they can apply to PDAP first.

If you have losses in more than one municipality, you must submit a separate application for each.

Documents needed for livestock losses

You must provide proof for all livestock losses. Accepted evidence includes:

- Photos or videos
- Inventory records
- CCIA tag numbers
- Purebred registration or parental lineage certificates

Claims without proof for each animal will not be paid.

Proof that insurance was not available

If livestock losses were caused by a heavy snow event and insurance was unavailable, you must provide an insurance denial letter. The letter must be on company letterhead and include:

- Your name and address
- Policy number and coverage type
- Land location and date(s) of loss
- Reason coverage was denied
- Signature and name of an authorized representative

Financial information required

In order to qualify, agricultural operations must have gross revenues between \$4,000 and \$2.0 million in the year pre-disaster. For livestock claims, you must submit:

- T1 Personal Income Tax Return with Schedule of Farming Activities, or
- T2 Corporate Tax Return (Schedules 1 and 125), if incorporated
- Corresponding CRA Notice of Assessment

Unaudited financial statements are not accepted.

Livestock losses covered by PDAP

When insurance is not available, PDAP may cover:

- Losses calculated using the P1/P2 Hybrid Inventory Valuation method used by the AgriStability program at the time of the disaster
- Equipment use related to the disposal of carcasses
- Medication costs

Livestock losses *not* covered by PDAP

PDAP will not cover losses for events where insurance is readily available. PDAP does not cover:

- Losses where insurance is available
- Snow clearing (considered regular maintenance)
- Wind breaks (materials or labour)
- Other assets bought for long-term use

Important notes about submitting claims

Your PDAP livestock claim cannot be assigned to an adjuster until all required documents are received.

To avoid delays, you may submit your application first and note that you are still gathering documents.

Submit the remaining documents as soon as possible.
