



BYLAW 02 – 2023

## A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Connaught No. 457, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
  - a. "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highways & Transportation Act, 1997*, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated in pursuant to the above Act.
  - b. "vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highways & Transportation Act, 1997*.
2. No person shall operate a vehicle at a greater speed of 50 kilometers an hour (50 km per hour) on the portion of public highway described as follows:

From the south east corner of the SE 14 47 14 W2, westward approximately 1.6 kilometers to the south west corner of the SW 14 47 14 W2.
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected showing the commencement of the speed zone area, and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
4. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of the Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
5. Bylaw 2-91 is hereby repealed.

6. This Bylaw shall come into force immediately.
